DESIGNATED CAREGIVER’S RESPONSIBILITIES

The designated caregiver must contact the school if the student will not be attending classes because of illness. Notification should be given as early as practicable (e.g. on the morning of the first day that the student will not be able to attend)

- Residential caregivers should provide the student with travel details to and from school and caregiver’s residence
- If a student requires non-urgent medical attention, the residential caregiver should take the student to their GP, to the caregiver’s own GP if the student does not have one or refer the student to the Crown Student Support Services
- In the event of a medical emergency involving the student, the residential caregiver should obtain medical assistance immediately and notify the accommodation or pastoral care person as soon as possible. It is the school’s responsibility to notify the parents
- Residential caregivers should advise the school of the family and student travel plans, and other student absences from the residence and/or school
- Residential caregivers must adhere to all relevant transport safety legislation, including those relating to the use of car restraints and bike helmets, and not overloading passenger vehicles.

STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Students to sign

- I am under 18 years old, and I understand that I have to abide by the school rules and procedures.
- I will attend all my classes and I will come to school on time every day.
- If I am late to school, I will call/text/email the student support team before 9:00 am.
- If I am absent from school for being sick or any other reasons, I or my caregiver will call/text/email before 9:00am.
- I will be home by 6:00 pm. everyday.
- If I wish to stay out late during weekends, I will get permission from my parents or caregiver. My parents / caregiver are required to confirm this via email to info@crown.ac.nz
- I will not smoke/vape. I will not drink alcohol. I will not use drugs.
- I will not bully, assault, fight with other students or staff members.
- I will not be in possession or use knives or other weapons.
- I will not engage in any activity of sending messages or images that may offend or harass another person by means of mobile phone or social media.
- I will not download or distribute offensive or copyrighted materials via the Internet or through social media and/or through digital devices such as mobile phones and computers.
- I understand that I will be given a first warning letter for: (1) violating school rules, unacceptable behaviour or low attendance at school, (2) unacceptable behaviour at homestay.
- If my behaviour does not improve, I will receive a second and then a third and final warning letter, I may be withdrawn from the School, and I will not be able to attend class anymore. I will not be entitled to a refund and my visa may be cancelled.
- I understand the school also has the right to withdraw me without warning at the discretion of the Management Team, in the event of any withdrawal, Immigration NZ will be informed of my conduct. This may lead to the cancellation of my visa.
- I understand that I have the right to have a person of my choosing to support and help me at meetings with school staff regarding my behaviour or attendance.
